

What to expect when at church

- You will be welcomed by a steward.
- Everyone will be wearing a mask (unless exempt).
- You will be required to sanitise your hands on entry and exit.
- There will be no singing.
- Shorter services 30mins to 45 mins max.
- All doors and windows will be left open-if you feel the cold make sure you wrap up warm.
- Your details will be noted for track and trace purposes.
- No handshakes or hugs.
- You will be shown where to sit. We will fill from the front first and we will leave from the back.
- Please leave the chairs where they are as they are marked out for 2 metre spacings.
- There will be one toilet open for anyone to use if needed. Sanitiser and cleaning facilities will be there for you to use.
- We will not have refreshments after the service.
- You will be encouraged to leave when the service has finished.
- If you wish to chat we advise you do it outside socially distanced.

What we expect from you

- Refrain from coming to church if you are feeling unwell or have experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the past seven days.
- Come early as we have limited seats-20 people.
- Take responsibility for your own safety and keep your belongings (coats etc) with you.
- In adverse weather please stay in your car until a steward lets you know when it is safe to come in.
- To be aware of social distancing at all times including the car park.
- Wear your mask until outside the building.
- If you wish to use a bible, bring your own.
- If you think you might need a drink, bring a bottle of water.
- If you feel ill at anytime please tell a steward who will get Julie Dickson who is the first aider.
- There will be a collection plate for you to put your collection in either as you arrive or leave.
- Please follow all guidance and direction of the duty stewards.
